PRAYER

BIBLE VERSE

Read Isaiah 40:12.

"Who has measured the waters in the hollow of his hand, or with the breadth of his hand marked off the heavens?

Who has held the dust of the earth in a basket, or weighed the mountains on the scales and the hills in a balance?"




I just tried to put a mountain in my scales, but I hurt my arm - those scales are heavy!



GAME

Take it in turns to name something. Each thing needs to be bigger than the one before. Start with 'ant'.



QUESTIONS

What's the biggest thing you got to?

What would Isaiah say if it was his turn next?
(Grab a Bible and look at verse 18 for a clue to Isaiah's answer...)

Why is it good news that God is bigger than anything else?
(Could he help us if there was something bigger than him?)



Because God is bigger, I'm going to trust him!




PRAYER

BIBLE VERSES

Read Romans 8:38–39.

"For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord."



CHALLENGE

Look at the list for 15 seconds (or read it aloud twice). Can you remember it all between you?

We'll, that's a very long list. I got a bit tired just reading it!



QUESTIONS

Why does the writer of Romans (Paul) list all these things?
(What is he saying about God's love?)

Where does Paul remind us that God's love found?
(In which person?)

Why is it good news for us that God is big and loving?
(What if he was big but not loving? What if he was loving but not big?)



Oh, that's why the Song says 'God is bigger' and 'God is loving'. It all makes sense now. Does that make me a genius?



PRAYER

Dear Father, thank you so much that nothing can separate us from your powerful love! Amen.
