Lord Jesus is different. He is the Prince of Peace, God clothed in humanity. He is the Way, the Truth and the Life. If we trust Him, we can find peace and eternal life when we die.

We don't know what your last words will be, but we do wonder what your next words will be. Will they be to turn from all your sins and believe in Jesus for salvation?

Would you make these words your next words?

"Yes, Lord Jesus, I repent of my sins. I ask you please to forgive me and become my Lord and Saviour."

Freddie Mercury

"It's better to burn out than to fade away."



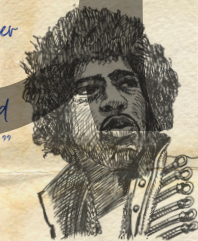
Kurt Cobain

the American guitarist. This is the last sentence of a poem written on his deathbed.



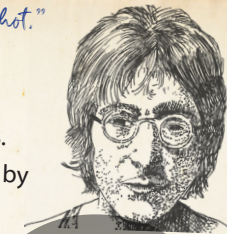
All three were only 27 years old.

one of the Beatles. He was shot dead by a fan outside the apartment where he lived. He was loving life with his wife and young son and had just released a new album that was selling very well. He had everything to live for, it seemed.

Marvin Gaye

writer and singer. He was shot by his father (who

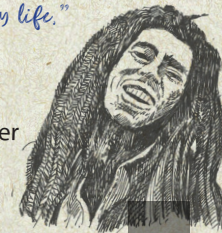
was later found to have a brain tumour) during a row.

Bob Marley

the Jamaican singer and composer. He died aged 36 from cancer that began in his toe.

He spoke these words to the audience at one of his last shows.



These are lyrics from the last song *Chuck Berry* (the father of rock and roll) recorded.

At one time, he was charged with child abuse and imprisoned for tax evasion.

Now lies each pillar and arch to perish

David Cassidy

the 1970s pop star. His attempt to relaunch his career had been unsuccessful and he had tried to hide his alcoholism.
